Membership pricing and limits, platform currency, fees, auction timing, moderation, collection confirmation, payout delay, categories, and regions can be changed by authorised administrators. The live application is authoritative for customer-facing values.

Browse categories, search structured content, filter and sort listings, compare up to three items, save favourites, and review seller profiles.

**T****Trade**

Purchase at fixed price, negotiate offers and counter-offers, or bid in auctions with configurable rules and payment windows.

**O****Operate**

Moderate listings, manage users and verification, resolve disputes, configure commercial rules, publish content, and review revenue.

**Delivered business outcome**

Hocuwa records and controls the marketplace workflow. Inspection, transport, handover logistics, veterinary checks, tax advice, and other real-world due diligence remain the responsibility of the trading parties.



## IDENTITY AND ACCESS

# Who uses Hocuwa—and how access works

Registration offers **Private** and **Business** account labels. They change profile presentation; they are not hard buyer-versus-seller permissions. Every registered account may buy and sell, subject to account state and the effective membership plan.

**Public visitor**

Browses listings, sellers, plans, blog and help content without a dashboard.

A

**Account owner**

Controls profile, trade activity, billing, payout setup, security, and eligible team access.

T

**Team member**

Signs in independently and works under the owner's seller identity. Billing remains with the owner.

AD

**Administrator**

Uses a separate protected portal for moderation, support, finance, content, settings, and audit work.

## Account lifecycle

**Register or sign in**

Email/password with terms and bot protection; optional Google sign-in when configured.

**Verify and secure**

Optional email OTP, password recovery, remember-me sessions, authenticator MFA, and backup codes.

**Complete profile**

Private or Business identity, contact information, country, preferences, and optional verification documents.

**Use the unified dashboard**

Buy, sell, message, manage transactions, membership, profile, verification, and settings.

**State enforcement**

Active, suspended, and deleted states are checked on protected routes.

**Separation of duties**

Marketplace user sessions and administrator sessions are separate. Administrative access is not derived from a normal marketplace session.

Public pages, account workflows, dashboard, and administrator portal are implemented in a single responsive web application. The codebase does not include separate native iOS or Android applications.



## PUBLIC MARKETPLACE

# From discovery to a confident decision

## Structured agricultural catalogue

Livestock, agricultural produce, animal feeds, farm machinery and equipment, and agricultural inputs and supplies.

**STEP 1****Browse or search**

Public categories, seller profiles, keyword and structured content search.

**STEP 2****Refine results**

Category hierarchy, method, price, and country filters.

**STEP 3****Sort & compare**

Newest, price, popularity, auction end; compare up to three.

**STEP 4****Review trust**

Seller profile, rating, verification, location, and listing details.

**STEP 5****Act**

Favourite, message, offer, bid, Buy Now, share, or report.

## Search coverage

Search includes listing titles, descriptions, locations, item and subcategory details, and seller or farm names. Results can be narrowed without requiring registration.

## Comparison fields

Category, type, age, weight, price, health, location, and seller rating are displayed where applicable to the compared listings.

## Listing detail

Structured attributes, media, documents, availability, location, seller information, and the permitted buying action.

## Activity signals

View tracking, favourites, sharing, and auction timing provide context without changing the authoritative transaction state.

## Safety action

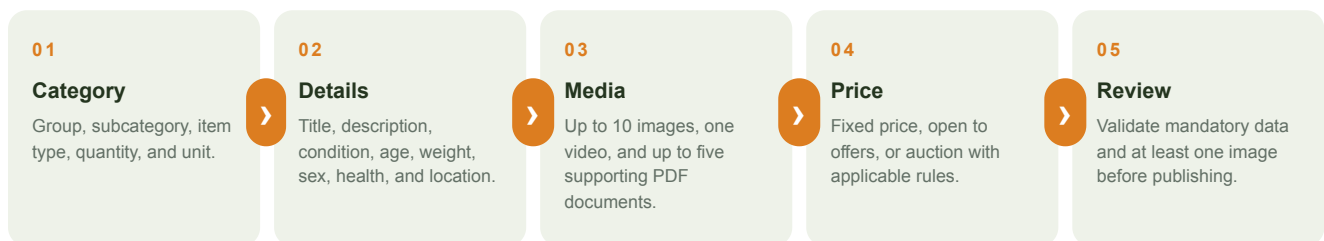
Authenticated users can report a listing; administrators review marketplace content through moderation controls.



## SELLER WORKFLOW

# Structured listing creation & control

The five-step wizard collects relevant category, product or animal, media, pricing, and review information. Fields appear according to the selected category and pricing method.

## Lifecycle rules

- ✓ Drafts do not consume the active-listing allowance.
- ✓ Manual moderation sends submission to Pending Review; otherwise it becomes Active.
- ✓ Stock decreases by one after each successful checkout.
- ✓ The listing becomes Sold when no quantity remains.

## History preservation

- Editing or removal is protected when offers or bids may be affected.
- Removal archives the record rather than destroying commerce history.
- Listing lifetime, video limits, boosts, and auction access follow the effective membership plan.



## CONTROLLED TRADING

# Three ways to trade



## Domestic transaction rule

The buyer's profile country must match the listing country before an offer, bid, Buy Now action, or checkout can proceed. Cross-border trade workflow is not delivered.

### FIXED PRICE

#### Immediate purchase

- One unit at displayed price
- Ownership, stock, status, and country validation
- Stripe Checkout session
- Payment confirmation reduces stock
- Collection confirmation and delayed payout

### OPEN TO OFFERS

#### Negotiated price

- One pending buyer/listing offer
- Accept, reject, counter, or withdraw
- Pending offers expire after 48 hours
- Acceptance creates an unpaid transaction
- Buyer pays from Transactions

### AUCTION

#### Competitive bidding

- Start/end, opening amount, and increment
- Optional Buy Now where configured
- Outbid notification
- Winner receives payment window
- Fallback to next distinct bidder if needed

## End-to-end transaction state

### INTENT

#### Buy / accept / win

A price and buyer are established.



### RECORD

#### Pending transaction

Server stores authoritative amount and parties.



### PAY

#### Stripe Checkout

Payment is confirmed by signed webhook.



### HANDOVER

#### Collection

Parties arrange real-world handover externally.



### SETTLE

#### Seller transfer

Net amount transfers after configured controls.

## Scheduled auction control

Background processing closes auctions, creates the winner's pending transaction, applies the configured payment window, advances to the next eligible bidder when necessary, and expires the listing when no valid path remains.

## Buy Now within auctions

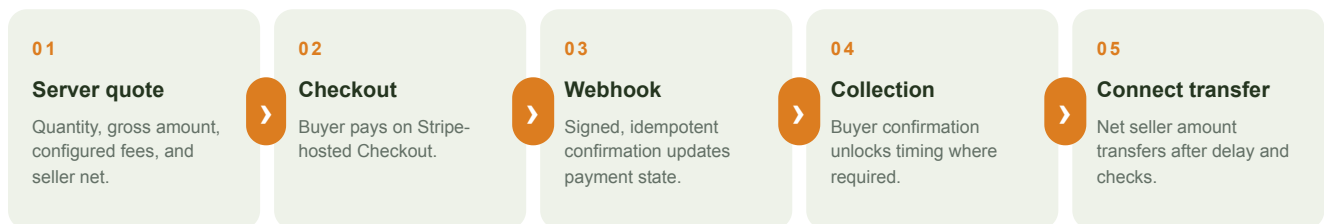
If Buy Now remains available, an eligible buyer can end the auction immediately at that amount and move into the payment workflow.



## COMMERCIAL CONTROLS

# Payment, collection & seller settlement

Buyer payments use Stripe-hosted Checkout. Hocuwa creates server-side quotes, records the transaction, treats signed Stripe webhooks as the authoritative payment signal, and transfers the eligible seller net amount through Stripe Connect.



## Payout readiness checks

- ✓ Payment confirmed and reconciled
- ✓ Collection requirement satisfied
- ✓ Configured delay elapsed
- ✓ No open dispute holding settlement
- ✓ Seller's Stripe Connect account is payout-ready

## Dispute workflow

1. A transaction party opens a case before payout processing.
2. Transaction enters Disputed status and normal payout progression stops.
3. Administrator assigns, reviews, records a resolution, and either releases the normal path or performs an eligible full refund.



## Currency behaviour

One administrator-selected platform currency controls listings, checkout, transactions, memberships, and reports. Approximate local-currency display may be shown, but checkout and accounting remain in the platform currency.



## Escrow-style, not legal escrow

Hocuwa delays a Stripe Connect transfer according to marketplace rules. It is not a separately regulated escrow account or legal escrow service.

## Receipts

Buyers can download a PDF receipt from an eligible transaction.

## Refunds

The admin workflow supports eligible full refunds, not partial refunds.

## Transferred funds

Normal admin refund is blocked after seller transfer and must be handled externally.

## Membership plans & enforced limits

Membership plans are database-driven and administered without code deployment. The seeded baseline below records the delivered starting configuration; the live Membership page is authoritative after administrator changes.

### Payment and commission model

Paid plans use one-time Stripe Checkout for a configured term; automatic recurring renewal is not delivered. Percentage, fixed, and marketplace service fees are plan-configurable and reduce the seller's net payout rather than increasing the buyer's item total.

## TECHNICAL FOUNDATION

# Application architecture

Hocuwa is a full-stack Next.js application. Public marketplace, user dashboard, administrator portal, server APIs, and business rules are delivered in one responsive deployment with a shared relational data model.





## CONNECTED SERVICES

# Data domains, integrations & automation

## Core data domains

### Identity

Accounts, profiles, sessions, security, verification, teams, preferences

### Marketplace

Listings, categories, media, documents, favourites, views, reports

### Commerce

Offers, auctions, bids, transactions, collection, payouts, disputes, reviews

### Operations

Plans, memberships, notifications, blog, adverts, settings, audits

### Persistent upload types

Listing images and video, supporting PDFs, profile avatars, verification documents, blog covers, and advertising creative are validated and stored in persistent server storage.

### Stripe

Checkout, webhooks, Connect onboarding, transfers, refunds

### SMTP

Transactional email with in-app notification continuity

## Hocuwa Application

### reCAPTCHA

Bot protection on selected public actions

### Lookup services

Country detection and approximate display-currency support

## Protected scheduled processing

### AUCTIONS

Close due auctions, create winner transactions, advance fallback bidders, expire unresolved listings.

### OFFERS

Expire pending negotiations when their 48-hour validity ends.

### LIFECYCLE

Expire eligible listings and memberships according to configured terms.

### PAYOUTS

Process seller transfers only when delay, collection, dispute, and Connect checks pass.



### Authoritative payment state

Signed Stripe webhooks are verified and handled idempotently. Return-from-checkout reconciliation provides continuity, but the server does not trust a browser redirect as proof of payment.

**!****Operational security responsibility**

Production credentials, SSH access, Stripe live keys, SMTP credentials, database backups, domain access, and administrator accounts must use an approved secret-management process. They must never be placed in public documentation, source control, or support screenshots.

**Private information**

Verification documents are accessible only to the submitting account and authorised administrators. Protected commerce information is restricted to transaction parties and authorised support operations.

**Release responsibility**

Named administrator accounts, MFA, least privilege, credential rotation, backups, patching, monitoring, and incident procedures remain ongoing operational responsibilities.

## Routine operational cadence

## Environment isolation

Staging data and test payment configuration must not be treated as production. Live credentials and customer data belong only in the approved production environment.

## Test interpretation

The separate Stripe suite requires approved test credentials and network access. Source-controlled tests are the executable specification; any saved browser report is a snapshot of a particular run.



## SCOPE CLARITY

# Current product boundaries

These boundaries prevent business users, support teams, and future maintainers from assuming adjacent capabilities that are not part of the delivered application.

**Domestic trade**

Buyer and listing country must match for offers, bids, Buy Now, and checkout. No cross-border workflow.

**One currency**

One platform settlement currency. Local display may be approximate; there is no multi-currency checkout.

**Collection**

Hocuwa records confirmation but does not book couriers, calculate shipping, schedule transport, or manage delivery.

**Settlement**

Delayed Stripe Connect payout is escrow-style workflow, not a regulated legal escrow service.

**Memberships**

One-time payment for a configured term; no automatic recurring renewal, proration, or self-service mid-term switching.

**Promotions**

Some advertising, logo, co-marketing, and support benefits are coordinated operationally.

**Reviews**

One buyer-to-seller review per paid transaction. Seller-to-buyer reviews are not delivered.

**Refunds**

Eligible full refunds only. No partial refund tool or automated post-transfer reversal.

**Messaging**

Messages, images, unread state, and notifications are delivered; socket-based live chat is not promised.

**Applications**

Responsive web application only; no native iOS or Android codebase.

**Advisory services**

No tax calculation, insurance provision, veterinary checks, or replacement for buyer due diligence.

**Handover**

Inspection, collection, transport, and off-platform documentation remain with the parties.



## Roadmap discipline

Requested additions should be recorded as separately estimated roadmap items. This preserves a clear final baseline for the delivered release.
